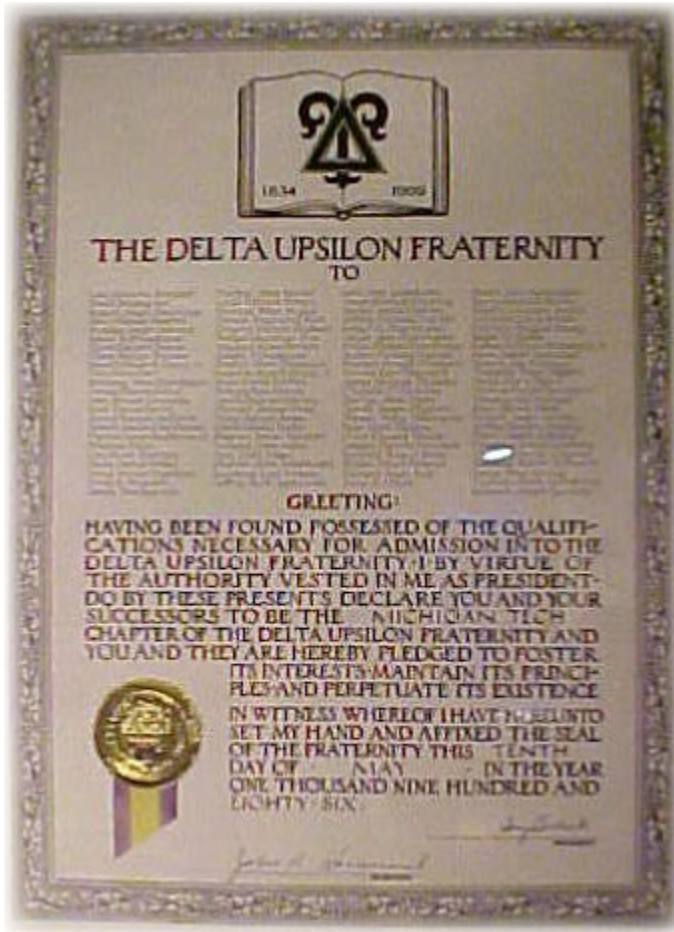

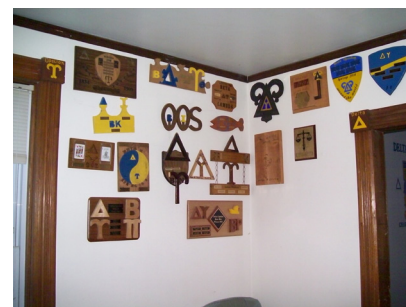
Dear Brother,

The Board of Directors for the Alumni Corporation has established the Michigan Tech DU Alumni Foundation to provide a means for collecting and recognizing donations from our Alumni. The goals of the foundation are to provide the basis for house improvements and to support the operations of the Alumni Corporation. The largest upcoming projects are focused on the roof, boiler, and 30th anniversary. Additional support may be lent to supporting the Undergraduate's community philanthropy and scholarship.

Since our inception we have relied upon the generous donations of Alumni of their talents, time, and money when we have called upon them in times of need. To provide our corporation the resources needed to help our Undergraduate Brotherhood the support they need to continue to live up to the ideals of our Fraternity, we are undertaking this new approach to attempt to raise an annual amount of \$13,000 from our Alumni. This amount may seem like a large amount when viewed by itself, but let us share with you how we arrived at this number. The amount is equal to the rent paid by the Undergraduate Chapter during the year. We now have over 300 Alumni Brothers from Michigan Tech; if every Brother was to contribute just \$43 in a one-time gift we would reach our goal.

To support this foundation we have been authorized to establish recognition levels to recognize those individuals that have provided their gifts to us on both an annual and a lifetime basis. The annual gifts will be established in accordance with our fiscal year of August 1st to July 31st. The giving levels are as follows:

Annual		Lifetime
\$50 - \$99	Duckling	\$1,000 - \$4,999
\$100 - \$249	Mallard	\$5,000 - \$9,999
\$250 - \$499	Silver Mallard	\$10,000 - \$24,999
\$500 - \$999	Golden Mallard	\$25,000 - \$99,999
\$1,000 +	Diamond Mallard	\$100,000 +



To recognize those brothers who have attained these giving levels, their names will be published in the newsletter that will be sent out during the first quarter of every year. This newsletter will provide you with a summary of the income and expenses that the foundation has incurred during the fiscal year.

In addition to the above levels, the Board of Directors has authorized the foundation to provide the following gifts to those that reach that appointed levels in coordination with our 30th reunion that is taking place on September 3rd - 5th, 2010.

Duckling Membership – Dinner at the Saturday Night Banquet
Mallard Membership – Scrapbook of the Weekend

We recognize that the current environment is not conducive to starting this endeavor, but we do feel that we need to start planning now to be able to provide the House and the Chapter the necessary support that they will require going forward.
